Registration Tour Cost

\$5,245 per person, double occupancy

\$10,490 per couple double occupancy

Includes – Round trip airfare & land package

Registration is based on first come first served. These tours sell out early, so we strongly suggest you register early to reserve your space.

Registration deposit: To reserve your space, send a minimum of **\$250 per person** registration deposit. You may cancel anytime for any reason with a full refund on all deposits, except for a **\$50 per person** admin fee up to **Feb 1, 2013**. To keep costs at a minimum, we do not accept credit cards.

Second payment is due February 1, 2013: A total of **\$3,000 per person** is now due which includes the registration deposit. All deposits are refundable before **June 1, 2013** except **\$1,500** per person. **Cancellation & medical travel insurance** is highly recommended at this point. Once your 2nd payment is received, we will be purchasing your nonrefundable airfare.

Final payment is due June 1, 2013: Total tour cost - 100% non-refundable.

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. **Single supplements** are available for a **private room for \$400 per person** additional.

Tour Cancellation / Interruption and Medical Insurance:

We strongly urge favorable consideration to coverage which provides financial protection for expenses related to cancellation, interruption and medical expenses caused by a covered reason as stated in the policy. This coverage pays for loss of deposits and additional expense due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you, a traveling partner or immediate family member. It also covers lost baggage, travel documents, medical expense, emergency assistance and accidental death. We recommend **Allianz Global Assistance** at www.allianztravelinsurance.com, 1-800-284-8300, formally known as **Access America**. The easiest way to get signed up is to simply call us. We can give you a quote and get you enrolled using your credit card. If you chose to purchase this coverage yourself, be sure to include our agency number **F027712** so they know it's with **Crisp Tours**. This is a separate insurance plan and is not connected to **Crisp Tours** in anyway.

Foreign exchange: The major risk factor in pricing your trip is based on the cost of the Euro. For every .01 increase above 1.50 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.52 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to **prepay your trip early**. This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the dollar.

Not included: Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed as advertised, ground transportation costs when doing own air arrangements or missed connections, personal items, telephone calls, trip cancellation & medical insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, two dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

Responsibility: We have made arrangements with airlines, hotels and other independent suppliers to provide you with the services you purchased. We have taken all reasonable steps to ensure that proper

preparations have been made for your vacation. However, we do not accept any liability for the actions or omissions of these independent suppliers, over whom we have no direct control. Airline Tickets: We will notify you of your airline itinerary as soon as we have made your reservations. Your tickets will be sent to you shortly thereafter, usually in the form of e-tickets via e-mail. It is important that you immediately check over your tickets to make sure everything is correct, especially the spelling of your name as it appears on your passport. It is your responsibility to have valid ID, passports and ticket information available at your port of departure.

Tour Extensions: If you plan to depart before or return later than the scheduled tour, or wish to purchase the land package only, you must let us know before **February 1, 2013**. We can usually arrange for a later return date at no extra cost if returning from Munich.

Land Package Only: If you wish to make your own air arrangements, upgrade to Business or 1st Class then subtract **\$800 per person**. You will then be responsible to meet our busses at the Munich Airport or at your hotel in Grassau. If you are unable to meet the busses because of your schedule, we may be able to arrange transportation to or from the hotel at your expense. Meet the Staff

Dan Nordbye: Dan is a native of Omaha, Nebraska, who now resides in Mesa, Arizona. Dan was introduced to square dancing at the age of 12. Eleven months later he was trying his hand at calling. From that moment on, Dan has pursued calling as his one and only profession. By the age of 16, he was Club Caller for 3 Omaha Square Dance Clubs. In 1976, he decided to pursue calling as a full-time profession. He now books dances and travels throughout the United States and around the world.

Dan has served on the CALLERLAB Mainstream and Plus Committees. He has attended 28 National Conventions, has served on many Panels and instructed various workshops.

Dan has been a recording artist since 1978 and has recorded several top ten hits.

Dan was hired as a resident caller in Mesa, Arizona in 1990 and has developed one of the most successful programs in the Valley, including all levels from beginners through A2.

Bob Baier: With over 42 years of experience, Bob is recognized as one of the nation's finest square dance callers. Bob started calling at the early age of 15 after taking square dance lessons at the age of 11. Bob calls in excess of 220 dance sessions a year.

Bob instructed his first square dance class in 1971 with 2 different teenage groups in Houston. Since he left Texas A&M in 1976 he has been a featured caller for many festivals and dances in over 32 states and internationally in countries. Bob worked with the Winter Texas in Pharr South for 19 years before taking a full time job with the Harris County Toll Road for the past 8 years.

In Houston Bob calls at various clubs around town and teaches two weekly mainstream/plus clubs and an Advance group (Bob's Best).

Born and raised in Houston Texas, Bob is married to his long time love Dena. He has two wonderful children Michelle (27) and Young Bob (25). Michelle and her husband Dustin have an 8 month old daughter, Bob and Dena's 1st grandchild.

Tom Crisp: Tom was first introduced to square dancing when his mom needed a partner for square dance lessons back in the 50's. As a kid, that didn't last long. He started calling in 1968 while stationed with the Canadians in Germany and has been active ever since. He has served as president of the European Callers & Teachers Association, the training director and began conducting several tours and vacation weeks while in Germany. Tom holds the record for calling for more clubs in Germany than any other American caller to include the Canadian 4 Wing Soelling Swingers, the Lahr Schwarzwald Tanzers, the Karlschue Kut-Ups, the Mainz Masters, the Sembach Buttons & Bows, the Bad Kreuznach Bridge House Twirlers and the Wiesbaden Grand Squares. Tom has called for several clubs after retiring from the Air Force in 1986 and currently travels as a guest caller for clubs around the country. He calls thru A2, but especially enjoys contras, quadrilles and traditional squares.

Your tour hosts, **Tom & Gina**, live in Tucson AZ where they operate a self-care horse ranch. Gina comes from the small Bavarian village of Koenigsdorf just south of Munich. They were married in Bad Toelz, Germany in 1964 and have two children and four grandchildren. Tom served 26 years in the USAF - half his military career was spent in Germany.
