Registration Tour Cost

\$5,145 per person, double occupancy
\$10,290 per couple double occupancy

Includes – Round trip airfare & land package

Registration is based on first come first served. These tours sell out early, so we strongly suggest you book early to reserve your space.

Registration deposit: To reserve your space, send a minimum of **\$250 per person** registration deposit. You may cancel with a total refund on all deposits, except \$50 per person admin fee up to **November 1, 2009**. To keep costs at a minimum, we do not accept credit cards.

After November 1, 2009 – Second payment is due: Send **\$2,750 per person** for a total of **\$3,000 per person**. This includes the initial registration deposit. Half is nonrefundable. When paying in full, **\$1,500 per person** is nonrefundable until **June 1, 2010**. We will be purchasing your nonrefundable airfare at this time.
 (Ask about Cancellation Insurance.)

After June 1, 2010 - Final payment due. Total tour cost - 100% non-refundable. Cancellation & medical travel insurance is strongly suggested.

Tour Cancellation / Interruption and Medical Insurance:

We strongly urge you to give favorable consideration to coverage which provides financial protection for expenses related to cancellation, interruption and medical expenses caused by a covered reason as stated in the policy. This coverage pays for loss of deposits and additional expense due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you, a traveling partner or immediate family member. It also covers lost baggage, travel documents, medical expense, emergency assistance and accidental death. Foreign exchange: The major risk factor in pricing your trip is based on the cost of the Euro. For every .01 increase above 1.50 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.52 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to **prepay your trip early**. This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the dollar.

Not included: Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed as advertised, ground transportation costs when doing own air arrangements or missed connections, personal items, telephone calls, trip cancellation & medical insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, three dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. **Single room supplements** are available for singles wishing to have a private room for an additional **\$400 per person**

If you are unable to meet the bus because of your schedule, we can arrange shuttle transportation to or from the hotel at your expense. Meet the Band**

Jeff Barnhart on Piano: Jeff is one of the busiest and most popular pianists in the country, traveling over 100,000 miles per year to fulfill hundreds of engagements. He has established himself as one of the most versatile musicians in the world. Jeff is a vocalist, arranger, bandleader, recording artist, composer, pedagogue, comedian and entertainer. He is featured on over 60 recordings. He manages the **Titan Hot 7**, one of the most acclaimed bands in the country, two bands in the UK, a quartet entitled **JAS'M**, enjoys great success smaller groups, most notably the trio **We Three** with **Draga & Coots** and **Ivory & Gold**, a duo with his wife, flutist **Anne Barnhart**.

Danny Coots on Drums: Danny started playing drums at the young age of 6. He continued his education at Crane School of Music and St. Lawrence University and later became faculty. Danny makes his home in Nashville where he joined the **Jack Daniels Silver Cornet Band** and also helped to found the **Titan Hot Seven**. He has recorded extensively in Nashville, New York and Los Angeles, having played drums on over 45 recordings, one of which received a Grammy in 2005. Danny has performed throughout the world, having appeared in over 70 countries.

Flip Oakes on Trumpet: Flip knew from the time that he could walk and talk that he wanted to make music and play trumpet. He made his professional debut at the age of twelve with his father's six piece Dixieland band in western New York. He continues playing jazz festivals, concerts, lounges, parties, wedding, political conventions, corporate parties and other affairs with his own group, The Flip Oakes Jazz Party Quartet.

Jerry Krahn on Guitar: Jerry brings his no-amps acoustic archtops to the stage and studio in the styles of early jazz guitar masters Eddie Lang and Django Reinhart. His arrangements of 20's and 30's jazz and pop standards are inspired and fresh sounding. Jerry carries these guitars into the 21st century with soulful versions of contemporary jazz, folk and personal compositions combining styles of Joe Pass, Chet Atkins, Pat Metheny and George Benson.

Ike Harris on Bass: As one of the very few native sons of Nashville in the music business, Ike Harris has performed with an amazingly diverse variety of artists and ensembles during his career. You may find him in a club with a jazz group, in the studio with a country artist, in a classroom with music education majors, or on a concert stage with an orchestra.

Bill Allred on Trombone: Bill's family has an extended musical background. He performed in College and the Navy and was a staff musician at Walt Disney World. Bill played over 12 years with the **Wild Bill Davison Jazz Band**, recording and traveling to festivals and concerts worldwide. Bill is now the leader of the very popular **Classic Jazz Band**. Bill continues to do occasional music work for **Walt Disney World** as well as run his own music production company.
