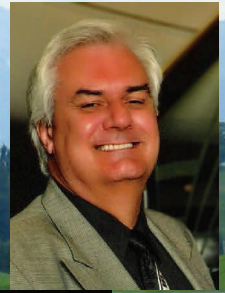

### Tour Cost

**\$5,850 per person, double occupancy**

**\$11,700 per couple double occupancy**

**Registration** is based on first come first served. These tours can sell out early, so we strongly suggest you register early to reserve your space.

**Registration deposit:** To reserve your space, send a minimum of **\$250 per person** registration deposit. You may cancel with a total refund on all deposits, except \$50 per person admin fee up to **February 1, 2015**. If you wish to use your credit card, give us a call.

**After February 1, 2015 – Second payment of \$3,000 total per person is due:** \$1,500 per person is nonrefundable until **June 1, 2015**. We will be purchasing your nonrefundable airfare at this time.

**After June 1, 2015 - Final payment due:** Total tour cost - 100% non-refundable. Cancellation & medical travel insurance is highly recommended.

**Tour prices** are based on two persons sharing one room. **Private single rooms** are available for an additional **\$400 per person**.

**Travel Insurance:** We strongly recommend Tour Cancellation / Interruption and Medical Insurance. This will provide financial protection for cancellation, interruption and medical expenses caused by reasons stated in the policy. This coverage pays for loss of deposits and additional expenses due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you, a traveling partner or immediate family member. It also covers lost baggage, travel documents, medical expenses, emergency assistance and accidental death. The easiest way to get signed up is to simply call us and we will enroll you in a personalized plan. This is a separate insurance plan and is not connected to **Crisp Tours** in anyway.

**Foreign exchange:** The major risk factor in pricing your trip is based on the cost of the Euro. For every .01 increase above 1.45 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.47 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to **prepay your trip early**. This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the dollar.

**Not included:** Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed as advertised, ground transportation costs when doing own air arrangements or missed connections, personal items, telephone calls, trip insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, three dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

**Responsibility:** We have made arrangements with airlines, hotels and other independent suppliers to provide you with the services you purchased. We have taken all reasonable steps to ensure that proper arrangements have been made for your vacation. However, we do not accept any liability for the actions or omissions of these independent suppliers, over whom we have no direct control. We cannot control such factors as weather, government travel restrictions, mechanical breakdowns, your physical, medical or

**Airline Tickets:** We will notify you of your airline itinerary as soon as we have made your reservations. Your tickets will be sent to you immediately thereafter, in the form of e-tickets via e-mail. It is your responsibility to have valid ID, passports and ticket information available at your port of departure.

**Tour Extensions:** If you wish to depart before or return later than the scheduled tour, or choose to purchase the land package only, you must let us know before **February 1, 2015**. We can usually make these arrangements at little or no extra cost to you.

**Land Package Only:** If you make your own air arrangements, upgrade to Business or 1<sup>st</sup> Class, subtract **\$900 per person**. You will then be responsible to meet our bus at the Munich Airport or at the hotel in Grassau. If you are unable to meet the bus because of your schedule, we may be able to arrange transportation to or from the hotel at your expense. ### Meet the Band

**Bob Draga - Clarinet:** It's easy to be mesmerized by the soft melodies from the classics, to the fast improvisations and jazzy jazz. Bob is a master musician with a sensational sense of humor, designed to compliment his Hall of Fame and Musician of the Year performances. Bob's professional career spans over forty years of live performances from around the world at jazz festivals, jazz cruises, and personal engagements.

**Danny Coots - Drums:** Danny started playing drums at the young age of six. He continued his education at Crane School of Music and St. Lawrence University to later become faculty. Danny makes his home in Nashville where he joined the **Jack Daniels Silver Cornet Band** and also helped to found the **Titan Hot Seven**. He has recorded extensively in Nashville, New York and Los Angeles, having played drums on over **90 recordings**, one of which received a Grammy in 2005. Danny has performed throughout the world, having appeared in **over 100 countries**.

**Bob Leary – Banjo:** Bob has been a Banjo King on Main Street at Disney World, the band leader and performer at Rosie O'Grady's in Orlando, and was a featured act and band leader, on the Mississippi Queen and the American Queen steamboats on the Mississippi river. He's had the honor of recording several CD's with Woody Allen's musical director, Dick Hyman. He has played jazz festivals in Tahiti, Germany, Holland, France, Britain, Canada, Israel and all around the United States.

**Bill Allred - Trombone:** Bill performed in College and the Navy and was a staff musician at Walt Disney World. Bill played over 12 years with the **Wild Bill Davison Jazz Band**, recording and traveling to festivals and concerts worldwide. Bill is now the leader of the very popular **Classic Jazz Band**. Bill continues to do occasional music work for **Walt Disney World** as well as run his own music production company.

**Dave Tatrow - Trumpet:** As leader and front man for **Wally's Warehouse Waifs**, Dave is one of the country's most popular Traditional Jazz trumpet players. His career started in 1979 as a lead horn player for the nationally renowned **New Reformations Band**. Over the past 30 years he has performed at virtually every major Traditional Jazz festival in the US. By day, he's the Village Manager of Reese, Michigan.

**Tom Hook - Piano:** Tom Hook worked for the Delta Queen Steamboat Company for a large part of his career as a lounge entertainer, band leader, cruise director, Manager, and Director of Entertainment. Also spending several years as a staff musician and featured entertainer at Walt Disney World, he has toured the world as a solo artist and with his own **Black Dog Band**, and appears nightly in New Orleans.

**Bobby Durham - Bass:** Bobby is a versatile multi-instrumentalist and entertainer for more than 30 years, performing all over the USA and around the world. Bobby worked as staff musician and entertainer in the Opryland Theme Park, on board the General Jackson showboat and at the Opryland Hotel as staff musician at Disney World. During the last ten years, Bobby has been Cruise Director and Bandleader for Delta Queen Steamboats of Mid-America.
