#### **Tour Package Cost**

\$5,975 per person, double occupancy \$11,950 per couple double occupancy Includes – Round trip airfare & land package

**Registration** is based on first come first served. These tours regularly sell out early, so we strongly suggest you register early to reserve your space.

Registration deposit: To reserve your space, send a minimum of \$250 per person registration deposit. You may cancel with a total refund on all deposits, except \$50 per person admin fee up to February 1, 2019. Personal check or money order. We are not setup to accept credit cards.

After February 1, 2019 – Second payment of \$3,000 total per person is due: \$1,500 per person is nonrefundable until June 1, 2019. We will be purchasing your airfare at this time.

**Final payment due <u>June 1, 2019</u>** Total tour cost and 100% non-refundable. Cancellation & medical travel insurance is highly recommended.

**Tour prices** are based on two persons sharing one room. **Limited private single rooms** are available for an additional \$400 per person.

**Travel Insurance:** We strongly recommend cancellation & medical insurance after **Feb 1, 2019** to protect 100% of your investment due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you or your traveling partner. It also includes lost baggage, missed connections, medical expenses and emergency assistance. You can review different insurance plans by going to **travelguard.com** or we can give you a quote for this protection. This is a separate insurance plan and is not connected to **Crisp Tours** in anyway.

Foreign exchange: We offer the lowest price possible for the features included with this tour. Compared to other European tours, we can't be beat. The major risk factor in pricing your trip in dollars based on the cost of the Euro. In the unlikely event the Euro increases higher than what we predicted, we could show a loss. Therefore, for every .01 increase above 1.25 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.27 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to prepay **your trip early.** This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the US dollar. If you need to cancel before Feb 1, 2019, all deposits will be refunded without question minus the \$50 admin fee.

**Not included:** Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed in brochure, ground transportation due to missed flights or when doing own air, flight upgrades, personal items, telephone calls, trip insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, two dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.
