Registration is on first come first served basis. These tours typically sell out early, we strongly suggest you register early to reserve your space.

Registration deposit: To reserve your space, send a minimum of **\$250 per person** registration deposit. You may cancel with a total refund on all deposits, except **\$50 per person admin fee up to February 1, 2021**. Personal check or money order. We cannot accept credit cards.

After February 1, 2021 – Second payment of \$3,000 total per person is due: \$1,500 per person is nonrefundable until **June 1, 2021**. We will be purchasing your airfare at this time. These are your tickets.

Final payment due June 1, 2021 Total tour cost and 100% non-refundable. Tour cancellation and medical travel insurance is highly recommended.

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. Limited private single rooms are available for an additional \$400 per person.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend cancellation & medical insurance after **Feb 1, 2021** to protect 100% of your investment due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you or your traveling partner. It also includes lost baggage, missed connections, medical expenses and emergency assistance. You can review different insurance plans by going to [USI Affinity Travel Insurance](http://www.usi.com) or we can give you a quote for this protection. This is a separate insurance plan and is not connected to **Crisp Tours** in anyway.

Foreign exchange: We offer the lowest price possible for the features included with this tour. Compared to other European tours, we can't be beat. The major risk factor in pricing your trip in US dollars based on the of the Euro exchange rate. In the unlikely event the Euro increases higher than what we predicted; we could show a loss. Therefore, for every .01 increase above 1.25 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.27 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to **prepay your trip early**. This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the US dollar. If you need to cancel before **Feb 1, 2021**, all deposits will be refunded without question less \$50 admin fee per person.

Not included: Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed in brochure, ground transportation due to missed flights or when doing own air, flight upgrades, personal items, telephone calls, trip insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, two dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

Tour Extensions: If you wish to depart before or return later than the scheduled tour, or you choose to purchase the land package only, you must let us know before **February 1, 2021**. In most cases, we can make these arrangements at little or no extra cost to you.

Land Package Only: If you wish to make your own air arrangements, subtract **\$900 per person**. You will then be responsible to meet our bus at the Munich Airport in the morning on Sep 14, 2021 or at the hotel in Grassau. If you are unable to meet the bus because of your schedule, we may be able to arrange transportation to and from the hotel at your expense. Two children, Joshua and Jacob, soon followed and his career picked up momentum. He found himself touring full time calling dances and festivals coast to coast and in a dozen different countries. Many recordings of Jerry's calling and teaching were made available to new dancers and callers throughout the world and have had a great influence in the growth of square dancing, especially in Saudi Arabia and Sweden.

In the spring of 2002, Jerry and Kristy, along with lifetime friend and business partner Tony Oxendine, opened Pride RV Resort in Maggie Valley, NC.

Jerry is dedicated to the preservation of Modern Western Square Dancing.

Tony has emerged as one of the most popular and sought-after national callers for festivals and dances. His professional musical background and natural ability has enabled him to reach an incredible vocal range unmatched by any other professional caller. He is a graduate of SC University, majoring in math and computer science – a perfect match for developing a choreographic callers' mentality. He travels over 300 days a year calling dances worldwide. He is an accredited caller coach, continues to serve on the CALLERLAB board of governors and has served as the organization's chairman of the board. Tony is the recipient of CALLERLAB's highest honor, the precious Milestone Award. In the spring of 2002, Tony, along with his lifetime buddies Jerry Story and Larry Letson opened Pride RV Resort and Maggie Valley Square Dance Vacations in Maggie Valley, NC.

Tom started calling in 1968 while stationed with the Canadians in Baden Sölingen AB, Germany. He served as president and training director of the European Callers & Teachers Association (ECTA) and conducted several tours and vacation weeks during his years in Germany. Tom served over half his military career in Germany where he eventually learned to speak fluent German.

Tom & Gina built their own square dance hall on their self-care horse ranch in Tucson AZ where they regular have classes and dances. Tom travels regularly as guest caller for clubs in and around the US. He especially enjoys doing contras, quadrilles, old fashion barn dances with live music. Tom recorded his first singing call "I'm Ready, If You're Willing" by Johnny Horton on Riverboat Records.
