Tour Cost

Registration is on a first come first served basis. These tours typically sell out early, we strongly suggest you register early to reserve your space.

Registration deposit: To reserve your space, please send a minimum of \$250 per person. You may cancel with a refund on all deposits, less \$50 per person admin fee prior to February 1, 2022. Personal check or money order only please. In keeping prices low, we do not accept credit cards.

After February 1, 2022 Second payment of \$3,500 total per person is due and half is nonrefundable prior to June 1, 2022.

June 1, 2022 Final payment due and 100% is non-refundable. Tour cancellation and medical travel insurance is highly recommended.

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. Limited private single rooms are available for an additional \$400 per person.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend cancellation & medical insurance after **Feb 1, 2022** to protect 100% of your investment due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you or your traveling partner. It also includes lost baggage, missed connections, medical expenses and emergency assistance. You can review different insurance plans and a no obligation quote by visiting to **USI Affinity Travel Insurance**. If you wish, we can purchase your plan using your credit card; however, keep in mind, this is a separate insurance plan and is not connected to **Crisp Tours** in anyway. Keep all receipts if an insurance claim is needed.

Foreign exchange: We offer the lowest price possible for the features included with this tour. Compared to other European tours, we can't be beat. The risk in pricing your trip in US dollars is based on the Euro exchange rate. In the unlikely event the Euro increases higher than predicted; we could show a loss. Therefore, for every .01 increase above 1.30 Euro to the dollar, there will be a price increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate increases to 1.37 to the dollar at the time of your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to **prepay your trip early.** This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the US dollar. If you need to cancel before **Feb 1, 2022**, all deposits will be refunded less a \$50 admin fee per person.

Not included: Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed as advertised, ground transportation costs when doing own air arrangements or missed connections, transportation costs, personal items, medical expenses, telephone calls, trip insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, three dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus

Airline Tickets: We will be purchasing airline tickets after **February 1, 2022.** We will notify you immediately after booking your airline tickets via e-mail. We ask you to verify your itinerary and confirm that your names match your passport. These airline e-tickets are your tickets. They are non-refundable and nontransferable. After booking, no changes can be made after 24 hours without a penalty. A voucher may be obtained for future travel one year from date of issue with a penalty.

Tour Extensions: If you wish to depart before or return later than the scheduled tour, or choose to purchase the land package only, you must let us know before **February 1, 2022.** In most cases, we can make optional arrival or departure date changes with the airlines at little or no extra cost to you.

Land Package Only: If you wish to make your own air arrangements, subtract \$900 per person. We ask that you send us a copy of your airline travel itinerary. You

will then be responsible to meet our bus at the Munich Airport in the morning on Sep 13, 2023 or at the hotel in Grassau. If you are unable to meet the bus because of your schedule, we may be able to arrange private shuttle transportation to and from the hotel at your expense. Note: Keep this information handy in case you need to find your own way to the hotel. Also available, within walking distance are a limited number of private apartments at no additional cost with kitchenette and separate bedroom at a first come, first served basis.
