Tour Package Cost

\$8,450 per person, double occupancy \$16,900 per couple double occupancy Includes – Round trip airfare & land package

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. Private rooms are available for an additional \$500 per person.

Registration is on a first come first served basis. These tours typically sell out. We strongly suggest early registration to reserve your space.

Registration deposit: To reserve your space, send a minimum deposit of \$250 per person. Personal check, money order or Zelle only please. You will receive a confirmation. To keep costs down, we do not accept credit card payments. You may cancel with a refund on all deposits any time prior to November 1, 2026, less a \$50 per person admin fee.

November 1, 2026 Second payment of \$4,000 total per person is due and \$2,000 is nonrefundable. We will start booking airline tickets at this time. Once you receive your airline booking, we request a confirmation.

<u>June 1, 2027</u> Final payment is due and 100% is non-refundable. Tour cancellation and medical travel insurance is highly recommended.

Passports: Must to be valid a min. of 3 additional months beyond your return date. Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend cancellation & medical insurance after November 1, 2025 when half your tour cost is due. Travel insurance protects 100% of your investment due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you or your traveling partner. It also includes lost baggage, missed connections, medical expenses and emergency assistance. You can review different insurance plans by going to USI Affinity Travel Insurance or we can give you a quote for this protection. This is a separate insurance plan and is not connected to Crisp Tours in any way. Keep all receipts for making insurance claims.

Foreign exchange: We offer the lowest price possible for the features included with this tour. Compared to other European Tours, it can't be beat. The major risk factor in pricing your trip in advance is the volatility of the exchange rate of the US Dollar to the Euro. In the unlikely event the Dollar weakens more than predicted; we could incur a loss. Currently, the Dollar to the Euro is reasonable. We may not be able to tolerate an exchange rate above \$1.20 to the Euro. We cannot be expected to take a loss and pay for your vacation. In the unlikely event, the exchange rate increases above \$1.20 to the Euro (i.e. the Dollar loses strength), for every .01 increase above \$1.20 to the Euro, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes \$1.27 to one dollar, when you make your final payment, there will be an increased surcharge of \$175 per person. (Ex. .07 increase or 7x25=175 or \$175 per person).

Not included: Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed in brochure, ground transportation due to missed flights or when doing own air, flight upgrades, personal items, telephone calls, trip insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, three dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

Responsibility: We have made arrangements with airlines, hotels and other independent suppliers to provide you with the services you purchased. We have taken all reasonable steps to ensure that proper arrangements have been made for your vacation. Airline Tickets: will be purchased after November 1, 2025 once your second payment is received. We will notify you immediately after booking your airline tickets via e-mail. We ask you to verify your itinerary and confirm that your names match your passport. These airline e-tickets are your tickets. They are non-refundable and nontransferable, however, if cancelled, a voucher may be obtained for future travel one year from the date of issue. After booking, no changes can be made after 24 hours without a penalty.

Tour Extensions: If you wish to depart before or return later than the scheduled tour, or you choose to purchase the land package only, you must let us know prior to **November 1, 2025.** In most cases, we can make optional arrangements at little or no extra cost to you.

Land Package Only: If you wish to make your own air arrangements, subtract \$1,000 per person. We ask that you send us a copy of your airline travel itinerary. You will then be responsible to meet our bus at the Munich Airport in the morning on Sep 16, 2026 or at the hotel. Please let us know which you choose. If you are unable to meet the busses because of your schedule or a missed connection, we may be able to arrange private shuttle transportation to and from the hotel at your expense.
