Sept 14 – Tuesday - Day 1 DEPART FROM YOUR LOCATION



Sept 15 – Wednesday - Day 2 ARRIVAL DAY / WELCOME RECEPTION

We arrive at the Munich Airport and meet at *Terminal 2 Information Center* where you will be greeted by Crisp Tours Staff. Look for the "i" as shown in the image on the left. Once everyone is accounted for, we will travel to the Hotel Farbinger Hof. During the drive you will start to experience the landscape unapparelled for its beauty. Sept 16 – Thursday - Day 3 FARMERS MUSEUM TOUR in AMERANG

Sept 17 – Friday - Day 4 SALT MINE / EAGLES NEST in BERCHTESGADEN

You will Learn exciting and informative facts about the underground world! Next stop will be the Eagles Nest known as Hitlers Mountain Retreat. Built in 1938 and accessible by a long tunnel and elevator adorned in polished brass. There you can enjoy lunch and explore the breathtaking 360° panoramic views. We return in time for dinner and Dancing.



Sept 18 – Friday - Day 5 ALPINE SKI LIFT / GRASSAUER ALM RESTAURANT

Enjoy an open air ski lift up the Hochplatte mountain with majestic views. Enjoy watching hang gliders, hiking or a traditional Bavarian lunch at the Grassauer Alm Restaurant. We return early enough for some down time. For dinner we travel to the Gasthaus Kampenwand for an evening of Invitational Square & Round Dancing. Sept 19 – Sunday - Day 6 OKTOBERFEST & OPENING PARADE - BBQ in MUNICH w/TAMARA TWIRLERS

We return to Munich to visit the 191st annual Oktoberfest known throughout the world and visited by more than 7 million visitors. Here you will enjoy all the festivities including beer tents and carnival attractions. Beware, each brewery makes a special Oktoberfest beer which packs a punch. On this particular day you will experience the opening costume parade featuring local and regional Bavarian's in their traditional dress, marching bands and horse drawn beer carriages adorned with flowers. A sight to be seen. We then join the Tamara Twirlers a local SD club for a BBQ of local cuisine and dancing.



Sept 20 – Monday - Day 7 HERRENCHIEMSEE CASTLE - OPTIONAL SCHNAPPS TOUR

A short ride to lake Chiemsee where we board a ferry to access Herren Chiemsee Island. King Ludwigs Herrenchiemsee Castle awaits. A short walk or take a horse drawn carriage takes you to the castle. Once there, explore the manicured grounds and elaborate fountain's prior to the castle tour. A café is available for lunch. We meet as a group at the boat dock landing at a designated time provided by Crisp Tours. An optional free Schnapps tour will be offered at the Hotel Weßner Hof this evening where you can learn the details of making schnapps. Sept 21 - Tuesday - Day 8 NEUSCHWA

NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE / OBERAMMERGAU VILLAGE

We travel to the town of Füssen where you will discover King Ludwigs Castle. Nestled upon a mountain top often referred to as the fairytale castle inspiring Walt Disney's sleeping beauty castle. This day will take some effort as there are over 300 steps in the castle alone. After the tour you will walk down the to the bus parking lot or take a horse drawn carrige ride. We will then head to the wood carving village of Oberammergau. Enjoy the fresco adorned buildings within the village. Home in time for dinner and dancing.



Sept 22 - Wednesday - Day 9 AUSTRIAN CITY OF INNSBRUCK / RATTENBERG AM INN

Innsbruck, the capital city of the Austrian State of Tyrol. Known for its many churches, winter sports and the city center walking district. Here, local tour guides accompany us on a bus and city walking tour. Enjoy free time, have lunch or additional exploring. A clock tower offers fantastic views. Next stop, the town of Rattenberg Am Inn, the smallest city in the country and land locked between the river Inn and the adjacent Rattennberg mountain. Known for Swarovski Crystal, glass blowing, quaint shops and cafes. Explore at your leisure prior to returning for dinner and dancing.



Sept 23 - Thursday - Day 10 MUNICH CITY OF TOUR - HOFBRAUHAUS

Returning to Munich to explore its rich history. A bus and walking tour will provide the city's historical significance as well as the origins of the Oktoberfest. Here you will also explore the old town passing through the city gates as they once stood during medieval times. In the city center you will see the famous Rathaus-Glockenspiel re-enacting scenes from Munich's history. The tour will end at the Hofbräuhaus where we will also meet prior to our return. There will be some free time to enjoy the city and all it has to offer based on individual desires. Once again we will return in time for dinner and dancing.



Sept 24 - Friday - Day 11 REIT IM WINKL / SCHUPLATTERS BAVARIAN SHOW

Visit the cozy village "Reit Im Winkl", located on the German and Austrian border known for summer and winter activities. Enjoy shopping, relaxing or exploring. Later this evening you will be treated to Heimatabend featuring a traditional Schuplattlers show, at the Gasthaus Kampenwand in Bernau. No dancing this evening. Dinner on your own.



Sept 25 - Saturday - Day 12 MICHAELI-MARKT GRASSAU

This day we will visit the neighboring town of Grassau for the Michaeli-Markt. This annual market day lines with street with vendors selling merchandise, food and of course beer. And yes live music as well. Mingle with locals. Many travel to participate in the festivities from within the region. This day is dinner on your own, but you will find everything and anything you may desire here. A shuttle will bring us back later that evening. There will be an optional special 50th Anniverdsay SD dance in Munich. Dinner available at the dance if you desire.



Sept 26 - Sunday - Day 13 AUSTRIAN CITY of SALZBURG - ST. RUPERTS DAY / MOZART DINNER CONCERT

Salzburg (Salt Fortress) is a city of music, history and architecture. This is the birthplace Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. A city walking tour takes you through the Mirabellgarden prior to reaching the old town. The tour ends at the St. Peter's Stiftskeller where we meet for the Mozart dinner concert later that evening. You will have free time to explore the city and enjoy the St. Ruperts festival. Visit the fortress accessable by a funicular for fantastic views of the city. No dancing this evening



Sept 27 - Monday - Day 14 FREE TIME / LAST DANCE / FAREWELL BANQUETTE

Enjoy the day for last minute shopping and packing. You may choose to visit the neighboring city of Bernau by local bus. The last dance will be early afternoon.
