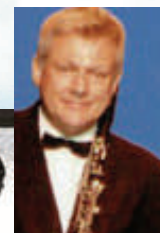

# Yerba Buena Stompers Germany & Austria Jazz Tour, Sep 12 - 26, 2012 – Terms, Conditions & Registration

## Registration Tour Cost

**\$5,145 per person, double occupancy**

**\$10,290 per couple double occupancy**

### Includes – Round trip airfare & land package

Registration is based on first come first served. These tours sell out early, so we strongly suggest you book early to reserve your space.

**Registration deposit:** To reserve your space, send a minimum of **\$250 per person** registration deposit. You may cancel with a total refund on all deposits, except \$50 per person admin fee up to **November 1, 2011**. To keep costs at a minimum, **we do not accept credit cards.**

**After November 1, 2011 – Second payment is due:** Send **\$2,750 per person** for a total of **\$3,000 per person**. This includes the initial registration deposit. Half is nonrefundable. When paying in full, **\$1,500 per person** is nonrefundable until **June 1, 2012**. We will be purchasing your nonrefundable airfare at this time.

(Ask about Cancellation Insurance.)

**After June 1, 2012 - Final payment due.** Total tour cost - 100% non-refundable. Cancellation & medical travel insurance is highly recommended.

**Tour prices** are based on two persons sharing one room. **Private single rooms** are available for an additional **\$400 per person**.

### Tour Cancellation / Interruption and Medical Insurance:

We strongly urge favorable consideration to coverage which provides financial protection for expenses related to cancellation, interruption and medical expenses caused by a covered reason as stated in the policy. This coverage pays for loss of deposits and additional expense due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you, a traveling partner or immediate family member. It also covers lost baggage, travel documents, medical expense, emergency assistance and accidental death. We recommend **Access America Insurance Services** at [www.accessamerica.com](http://www.accessamerica.com), 1-800-284-8300. The easiest way to get signed up is to simply call us and we will enroll you. If you chose to purchase this coverage yourself, be sure to include our agency number **F027712** so they know it's with Crisp Tours. This is a separate insurance plan and is not connected to **Crisp Tours** in anyway.

**Foreign exchange:** The major risk factor in pricing your trip is based on the cost of the Euro. For every .01 increase above 1.50 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.52 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to **prepay your trip early**. This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the dollar.

**Not included:** Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed as advertised, ground transportation costs when doing own air arrangements or missed connections, personal items, telephone calls, trip cancellation & medical insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, three dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

**Responsibility:** We have made arrangements with airlines, hotels and other independent suppliers to provide you with the services you purchased. We have taken all reasonable steps to ensure that proper arrangements have been made for your vacation.

However, we do not accept any liability for the actions or omissions of these independent suppliers, over whom we have no direct control. Please understand also that we cannot control such factors as weather, government travel restrictions, mechanical breakdowns, your physical, medical or mental disabilities, your failure to obtain proper travel documents or your failure to follow travel instructions. **Airline Tickets:** We will notify you of your airline itinerary as soon as we have made your reservations. Your tickets will be sent to you shortly thereafter, usually in the form of e-tickets visa e-mail. **Land Package Only:** If you wish to depart before or return later than the scheduled tour, or wish to purchase the land package only, please let us know your intentions not later than **November 1, 2011**. We can usually arrange for a later return date at no extra cost if returning from Munich. If you wish to do your own air arrangements, upgrade to Business or 1<sup>st</sup> Class, subtract **\$750 per person**. You will then be responsible to meet our bus at the Munich Airport or at your hotel in Grassau. If you are unable to meet the bus because of your schedule, we may be able to arrange transportation to or from the hotel at your expense. ## The Yerba Buena Stompers Meet the Band

**John Gill on Banjo & Band Leader:** John has been playing the banjo since 1964. He developed his love of traditional jazz by listening to the records of Lu Watters, and Turk Murphy. From 1977 to 1986 John was privileged to be a member of Turk Murphy's Jazz Band. John is also a drummer, and guitarist. He has appeared in films ("The Aviator", "Wild Man Blues"), on television ("The Tonight Show", "Late Night with Conan O'Brien") and on stage (Carnegie Hall). Performs regularly with Vince Giordano's Nighthawks, and Woody Allen's New Orleans Jazz Band.

**Duke Heitger on Trumpet:** Duke is a rising star among a growing number of young musicians who specialize in traditional jazz. He is based in New Orleans and is in great demand as a leader and sideman. He is a

regular guest on the nationally syndicated radio program "A Prairie Home Companion" and he tours regularly with Butch Thompson. He can also be seen and heard at major jazz festivals all over the world.

**Leon Oaklev on Trumpet:** Leon is one of America's greatest hot trumpet players. Originally from New York state, Leon moved to San Francisco in the 1960's to play with Turk Murphy's Jazz Band. A master of the hot blues based playing of King Oliver, Louis Armstrong, and Red Allen, his playing has livened up many a band including the great South Frisco Jazz Band.

**Tom Bartlett on Trombone:** Tom is an expert in the style of jazz legend Turk Murphy. Tom hails from Chicago where since the 1950's has performed with The Original Salty Dogs, and many other traditional jazz groups. He has been in The Peace Corps, the Army, and is a bilingual teacher. Also handy with a vocal chorus.

**Orange Kellin on Clarinet:** Originally from Sweden, Orange has been living in New Orleans since 1966. Over the years he has worked with many jazz legends including Louis Armstrong, Kid Ory, Zutty Singleton, Jabbo Smith and Jim Robinson just to name a few. Appears on the festival circuit with his own New Orleans Blues Serenaders, and "The Manhattan Ragtime Orchestra. These days when he isn't touring in Europe, he splits his time between New York City and New Orleans.

**Marty Eggers on Piano:** Marty's music career began in Sacramento California in the early 1980's. His piano style is grounded in the ragtime based playing of early jazz masters like Jelly Roll Morton, Jimmy Blythe, and Lil Hardin. He also carries on the west coast traditions of Wally Rose and Paul Lingle. He is very active as a piano soloist, and is also a well known bass player.

**Kevin Dorn on Drums:** Born in New York City, Kevin took up drumming at the age of 14. Since then, he has become one of the busiest drummers in traditional jazz. Kevin was the drummer for the Jim Cullum Jazz Band, the nation's foremost traditional jazz group, appearing on their weekly public radio show, Riverwalk: Live from The Landing.

**Clint Baker on Tuba:** Clint was originally the band's drummer, but has made the switch to the tuba chair. Clint is a masterful multi instrumentalist at home on drums, tuba, trombone, banjo, guitar, cornet, and clarinet. His expertise in the intricacy and secrets of authentic New Orleans jazz make him an important part of any band.
